

COLOSSIANS WORKBOOK SESSION EIGHT – WORD OF TRUTH

Introduction

In his letter to the Colossians, Paul magnifies the supremacy of Christ and the transformative power of the gospel. The phrase 'Word of Truth' points us to the message that carries divine authority and eternal life. It is not merely a philosophy or opinion—it is the revelation of God's redemptive plan through Christ Jesus. The Word of Truth anchors believers against deception and grounds us in the reality of God's grace and purpose.

I. Definition: The Word of Truth

The Word of Truth refers to the authentic message of the Gospel—the revealed truth of God that brings salvation, transformation, and spiritual maturity to all who believe.

“Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints, For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel.”

— Colossians 1:4–5 (KJV)

The Word of Truth is not flexible to culture or opinion; it is fixed in God's unchanging nature. It reveals who Christ is, who we are in Him, and how the Spirit of Truth guides us into all truth.

II. The Role of Truth in the Believer's Life

Truth sanctifies. Truth cleanses. Truth stabilizes. When Paul speaks of the 'Word of Truth,' he identifies the Gospel as the power that uproots deception and restores divine alignment in the human heart.

“Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.”

— John 17:17

“Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.”

— James 1:18

The believer who walks in truth walks in light. As the Word of Truth abides within us, our speech, actions, and discernment begin to reflect Christ Himself.

III. Living by the Word of Truth

The Word of Truth is not only to be heard—it is to be lived. We demonstrate the reality of the Gospel when we let truth govern our decisions, conversations, and relationships. Walking in the Word of Truth means embracing transparency, integrity, and obedience to God's voice even when it challenges our comfort.

Reflection Thought: The world changes through authenticity, not pretense. When truth rules the heart, Christ is revealed through us.

2. How does truth bring freedom and stability to your walk with Christ?
3. What area of your life needs a renewed submission to God's truth today?
4. How can the Word of Truth guide you in responding to deception or confusion in the world?
